

- Students find UCF info on the web in an equally distributed percentage of Search, Browsing, and Direct links.
- Mobile is a large percentage of traffic for UCF students

Con: app crashed when choosing event




Competitor B: University of Calgary Con: no events and no search




Competitor C: University of Florida
